

Introducing new ways to recycle and reuse!

As a way to encourage more residents to participate in waste reduction, Takasago entered into cooperation agreements on October 1, 2025, with service providers that offer recycling- and reuse-related services. Please consider using these services and cooperate with recycling and reuse.

Recycling of personal computers and four home appliances (televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, air conditioners)

Takasago has signed cooperation agreements with ReNet.jp Recycle Co., Ltd. and SG Moving Co., Ltd.

Under the Act on Promotion of Recycling of Small Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment

Please cooperate with the proper collection and disposal of computers that are no longer needed

When a box includes a personal computer, collection fees for that box are **free.**

[Secure data erasure] Data is erased safely and reliably at a government-certified facility!

Personal computers that are no longer needed at home can be collected free of charge by courier from your home (as early as the next day, at your desired date and time). Use the service as follows:

- 1 Apply**
Apply via the Internet, fax, or phone.
- 2 Pack the items**
Simply pack them in a cardboard box or similar container.
- 3 Sagawa Express collects the items**
Sagawa Express will pick them up at your requested date and time.

- Collection fees and recycling fees for one box that includes a personal computer are free.
- All types of computer are accepted, even old or broken devices.
- Peripheral devices and other small household appliances can be collected with computers.

Televisions, refrigerators, and similar items that were difficult to dispose of at home can now be collected from inside your residence. There is no need to move heavy items yourself.

Apply easily online or by phone!
- Point 2**
Have items removed from inside your home (living room, kitchen, etc.)
*Service not available for indoor or outdoor air conditioner units.
- Point 3**
No need to purchase a recycling ticket in advance!

- In keeping with the Home Appliance Recycling Act, recycling fees and collection/transport fees apply depending on the item and size.
